2022-23 Uniforms & Personal Appearance

All students are expected to be neat in appearance and to wear the school uniform in the way it is intended to be worn. The following are our guidelines for boys' and girls' uniforms and personal appearance during the regular school day, with separate sections further down for special events, and choir concerts.

BOYS' UNIFORM & APPEARANCE GUIDELINES

Please reference the following guidelines for boys' uniforms and personal appearance. If and when questions arise regarding the application of these guidelines for boys, our policy at Trinity School is to defer to the final judgment of the dean of boys. Approved uniform pieces	Approved pants, shorts, shirts, sweaters, polar fleeces, and sweatshirts should be purchased at www.globalschoolwear.com . Be sure to use the sizing guide offered through the website before ordering. Sizes run small. To find our school store use the code TRIN15. When you click through to the website, you must fill in all of the search fields (i.e., school, grade, gender, and program) and click "update" to bring up the right selection of Trinity School's uniform pieces for your child.
Hair	Hair must be cut short and neat. Hair cannot extend over the shirt collar in the back, over the ears, or over the eyes. Shaved heads are not permitted, nor is shaggy hair. Sideburns can come to the bottom of the ear (or shorter). Boys must be clean-shaven every day.
Accessories and personal appearance	Bracelets, earrings, and other jewelry are not allowed, with the exception of a wristwatch and a religious medal if approved by the dean. Visible tattoos or body piercings are not allowed. Uniform shirts must be tucked in. A plain black or brown belt must be worn.
Shorts	Approved uniform shorts may be worn until Fall Break and after Spring Break each calendar year.
Undershirts	T-shirts worn under the uniform must be a plain white crew neck or v-neck.
Socks	Socks must be plain navy, black, or white socks without a logo. Crew or ankle length is acceptable.
Sweatshirts	Trinity School crew and hoodie-style sweatshirts are now available for

	purchase at our online uniform store. With these options now available, no other sweatshirts or hoodies may be worn on the campus grounds.
Shoes	Shoes must be plain, dark brown, or black dress-casual shoes (tie or slip-on) with a black or dark brown sole. All-black athletic shoes with a black sole may also be worn. Sandals, slippers, and shoes with visible logos are not acceptable. If you are uncertain about a particular shoe style, talk to the dean of boys before purchasing.

GIRLS' UNIFORM & APPEARANCE GUIDELINES

Approved uniform pieces	Approved pants, skirts, shorts, shirts, sweaters, polar fleeces, and sweatshirts should be purchased at www.globalschoolwear.com . Be sure to use the sizing guide offered through the website before ordering. Sizes run small. To find our school store use the code TRIN15. When you click through to the website, you must fill in all of the search fields (i.e., school, grade, gender, and program) and click "update" to bring up the right selection of Trinity School's uniform pieces for your child.
Hair	Hair color must be natural. Hairstyles should be worn in a manner that is appropriate for school.
Accessories and personal appearance	Jewelry and makeup should be worn in a manner that is appropriate for school. Visible tattoos or body piercings are not allowed. Students may wear one earring in each ear, one bracelet, and one necklace. A plain white camisole is permissible under the uniform.
Hemlines	The hemline of skirts may be no more than two inches above the top of the knee.
Shorts and leggings	Approved uniform shorts may be worn until Fall Break and after Spring Break each calendar year. Shorts and leggings worn under skirts must be purchased through the uniform provider.
Socks	Socks must be plain navy, black socks, or white socks without logos or patterns of any kind. Ankle, crew, or no-show lengths are acceptable. No knee-high socks may be worn. Plain, unpatterned navy or black tights or nude nylons may be worn as well.

Belts	Belts are optional. If a belt is worn, it must be dark brown or black.
Sweatshirts	Trinity School crew and hoodie-style sweatshirts are now available for purchase at our online uniform store. With these options now available, no other sweatshirts or hoodies may be worn on the campus grounds.
Shoes	Shoes must be black or dark brown leather shoes with a black or dark brown sole in oxford, flats, Mary Jane, or lace-up style. Slip-on leather loafers and all-black athletic shoes with black soles are also acceptable. High-top, combat-style boot, bootie, Birkenstock, moccasin, sandal, clog, and slipper-style shoes are not acceptable, nor are light brown shoes. The laces must be the same color as the shoes. If you are uncertain about a particular shoe style, talk to the dean of girls before purchasing.

ATTIRE FOR SPECIAL EVENTS

Students may not change out of their uniforms at school unless they are members of an athletic team practicing or playing immediately after school. Once students have changed into their sports uniforms for practice, they must leave the school building. In other cases, students should obtain the permission of the appropriate dean to change clothes at school by submitting a written request from the parents.

Field Trips	In general, all uniform guidelines apply to students on field trips. Any special provisions suited to a particular trip (e.g., good walking shoes) will be communicated by faculty to students in advance of the trip.
Field Day	Students should wear apparel appropriate for participation in athletics. T-shirt, relaxed athletic shorts or joggers, and athletic shoes.
Evaluations, Recitals, Fine Arts Nights, & Commencement	Boys should wear a dress shirt, dress pants, dress socks, and dress shoes with a belt and tie. A jacket is optional for most events. Girls should wear a blouse and dress pants, or a blouse with a skirt or dress with a hemline of 2" above the knee or longer. Dress shoes or dress sandals are required. No converse or high tops are permitted.

ATTIRE FOR CHOIR PERFORMANCES

It is required that all students performing in Choir (ninth and tenth-grade students and juniors and seniors in Chamber Choir) wear a choir uniform. This uniform is available through Cousins Concert Attire (www.ConcertAttire.com) and is identical to what the students have worn in previous years. You may obtain a used uniform from a former Trinity School student or order a new one.

Girls' Choir Uniform	Girls wear the Angelina gown in black. The style number in the catalog is #115 (or #115Y if ordering a youth size). This dress seems to run large. Please use the size chart on the website to help you choose a size. For anyone under 5'11", this dress will need to be hemmed to fall between ankle and floor-length. Girls should plan to wear neutral or black dress shoes and are permitted to wear simple jewelry. No converse or high tops may be worn.
Boys' Choir Uniform	Boys wear the Vincent shirt with pants in black. The style number in the catalog is #6701. This set includes a shirt, tie, and trousers. The tie color required is hunter green. You have the option to order boys' items a la carte if necessary. The tie is style #900, the pants are #3024P, and the Laydown Collar Non-Pleated shirt is #M03, color black. The pants will arrive unhemmed. Boys should wear black dress shoes.
